

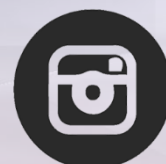

ARTICLE 1

Definition

This document contains the rules concerning the IX In4Med Photography Contest of Núcleo de Estudantes de Medicina da Associação Académica de Coimbra (NEM/AAC).

ARTICLE 2

Purpose and theme

- The purpose of this competition is to challenge the creativity of the participants and to encourage them to be involved in more than just science during the congress.
- The contest is intended to portray the activities of the Congress, considering the participants' points of view, encouraging them to explore and share their creative self.

ARTICLE 3

Participation terms

- The contest is for participants of the IX In4Med.
- Participants must apply individually. Teams won't be accepted.
- Each participant can submit an unlimited number of photographs, corresponding each to a participation.
- Members of the Organising Committee, Task Force and the Jury can't participate in the contest.

ARTICLE 4

Access to technical specifications and conditions of participation in the photography category

- Participants must submit a photograph with the following characteristics:
 - The photographs can be in colour or in black and white;

- There are no limits related to image editing or to its size. Filters can be used.
- All projects submitted to the competition must be completely original and unpublished.
- The photographs must be posted publicly on the participants' Facebook page or in their Instagram account with the following hashtags: #In4MedIX and #LightingtheWayStartingToday.
- Competitors are responsible for the originality of the work submitted, ensuring its own and full responsibility for any claims in respect to copyright and related rights.

ARTICLE 5

Registration and submission of the photograph

- The registration period will run until 1 p.m. of the 1st of March 2019.
- The competitors allow In4Med to use their work for advertising the In4Med Photography Contest, from the time of their submission.

ARTICLE 6

Withdrawals

- In this situation, the participant must inform the Organising Committee and justify the withdrawal as soon as possible.

ARTICLE 7

Jury and evaluation

- A jury will evaluate the submissions. It will be composed of three members of the Organising Committee of the IX In4Med Congress and a member of the *Secção de Fotografia da Associação Académica de Coimbra (SF/AAC)*. Points will be scored for originality, photographic composition, technique and relevance to the congress motto (*Lighting the way, starting today*).
- The jury's final decision will be known on the 1st of March 2019 at the Closing Ceremony.
- There will be no appeal from the decisions of the jury.

ARTICLE 8


Awards and winners

- According to the rules above mentioned, the 3 best photographs will be distinguished accordingly.
 - 1st place
 - A voucher for a photography course by SF/AAC. This voucher allows the winner to choose a general or specific photography course, such as night photography or landscape photography;
 - A free photographer credential for *Queima das Fitas* 2020.
 - A voucher for a training course by FLAG, in the amount of 500€.
 - 2nd place
 - A voucher for a training course by FLAG, in the amount of 300€.
 - 3rd place
 - A voucher for a training course by FLAG, in the amount of 150€.


ARTICLE 9

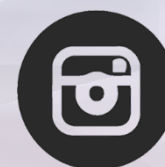
