ARTICLE 1

DEFINITION

This document contains the rules concerning the In4Med Photography Contest of Núcleo de Estudantes de Medicina da Associação Académica de Coimbra (NEM/AAC).

ARTICLE 2

PURPOSE AND THEME

- The purpose of this competition is to challenge the creativity of the participants and to encourage them to be involved in more than just science during the congress.
- The contest is intended to portray the activities of the Congress, considering the participants' points of view. It is intended that each work should reveal a unique and original look at a fragment of the surrounding reality.

ARTICLE 3

PARTICIPATION TERMS

- The contest is for participants of the VIII In4Med.
- Participants must apply individually. Teams won't be accepted.
- Each participant can submit an unlimited number of photographs, corresponding each to a participation.
- Members of the Organising Committee, Task Force, the Jury and their immediate relatives can't participate in the contest.

ARTICLE 4

ACCESS TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION IN THE PHOTOGRAPHY CATEGORY

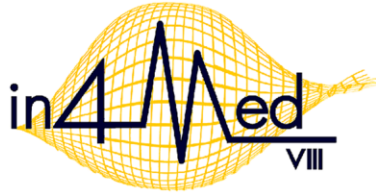
- Participants must submit a photograph with the following characteristics:
 - The photographs can be in colour or in black and white;
 - The photographs should be posted publicly on their Facebook pages or in their Instagram with the following hashtag: #in4med.
 - Note: their Instagram profiles should be public.
- There are no limits related to image editing or to its size. Filters can be used.
- All projects submitted to the competition must be completely original and unpublished.
- Competitors are responsible for the originality of the work submitted, ensuring its own and full responsibility for any claims in respect to copyright and related rights.

ARTICLE 5

REGISTRATION AND SUBMISSION THE PHOTOGRAPH

- The registration period will run until 1 pm of the 24th of February 2019.
- Competitors allow In4Med to use their work for advertising the In4Med Photography Contest, from the time of their submission.

ARTICLE 6

WITHDRAWALS

- In this situation, the participant must inform the Organising Committee and justify the withdrawal as soon as possible.

ARTICLE 7

JURY AND EVALUATION

- A panel of judges will evaluate the submissions, consisting of members of the Organising Committee of the VIII In4Med Congress and by an entity with knowledge in the photography field. Points will be scored for originality, photographic composition, aesthetics, technical and other aspects.
- Their evaluations will be known on the 24th February 2019 at the Closing Ceremony.
- There will be no appeal from the decisions of the Jury.

ARTICLE 8

AWARDS AND WINNERS

- According to the rules above mentioned, the best photograph will be distinguished, winning a voucher for a photography course by Secção de Fotografia da AAC. The voucher allows the winner to choose a general photography course or a specific one, such as night photography or landscape photography, and to have a free photographer credential for Queima das Fitas 2019.
